The successful candidate will join the Research Group [Multiscale Calculus of Variations](#) led by [Elisa Davoli](#) at the [Institute of Analysis and Scientific Computing](#) of TU Wien in Vienna, Austria as a praedoc University Assistant.

Ideal candidates would have a strong background in calculus of variations, geometric measure theory, nonlinear evolution equations, or in applied analysis. A basic knowledge of German or the willingness to become proficient in German in a short time are a prerequisite, for a big portion of the teaching is expected to be in German.
